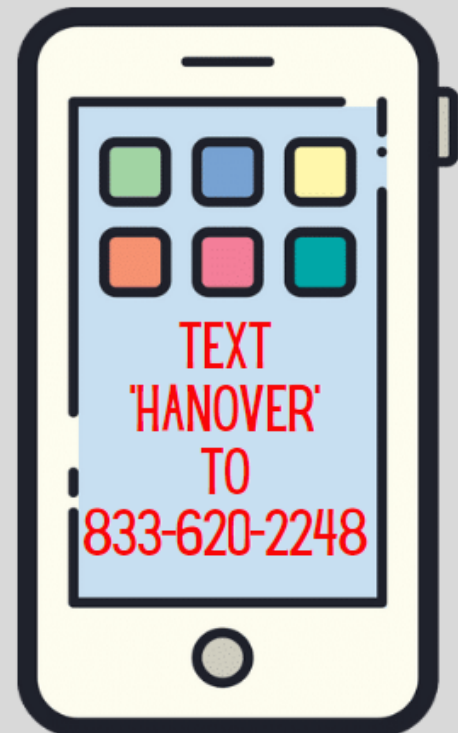

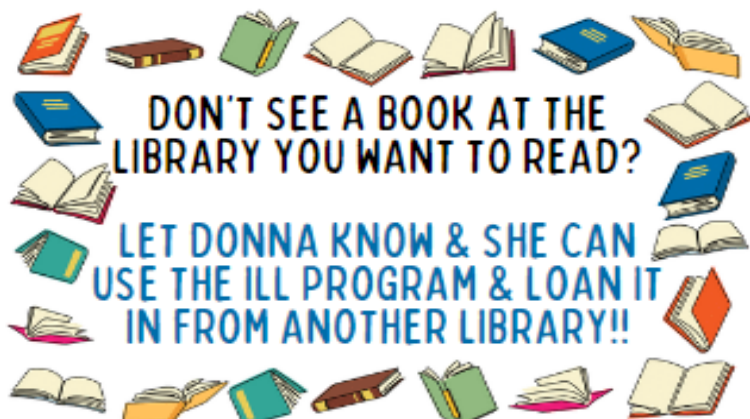

City of Hanover Dumpsite Clean Out Bid

The City of Hanover is accepting sealed bids for the removal and cleanup of the city dumpsite.

Job Requirements

- Remove and haul away brush and yard/garden debris from the dumpsite
- Bidder **must** have a location to dump debris and brush
 - City of Hanover does not have a location for this
- Cleanup **must** be completed within 2 weeks of acceptance of bid (April 10, 2024)

Bids are due to the city office no later than **APRIL 10, 2024 by 5:00pm**. Please label all seal bids "Dumpsite Clean Out". Bids will be opened during the city council meeting on April 10, 2024. Meeting begins at 6:00pm.

City office hours are Monday-Thursday 8a-5p and Friday 8a-12p; there is a dropbox available to drop sealed bids if after hours.
