2024 Spring into Health Fair By Aubrie Schaefer, MSN, APRN, FNP-C



Please make plans to attend our health fair this weekend, April 6th from 7am to 10am. We had such a great time making this event happen last year that we decided to make it happen annually!

You need not be a patient of our clinic to attend! Lab results will be mailed to you and from there you can take them to your primary care provider for further discussion.

The following is a brief explanation of the lab tests being offered:

*CMP: This is to check your kidney function, liver function, electrolytes—very useful for detecting chronic health conditions early. Cholesterol/lipids: be sure to fast for 12 to 14 hours before this test. Keeping your cholesterol in check is important for stroke and heart attack prevention.

*CBC: This test looks at your white blood cells, red blood cells, platelets, hemoglobin. This test gives us an idea of how your body makes blood. Very useful test for screening for infections and other blood disorders.

*A1C: Let's be sure you don't have undiagnosed diabetes!

*TSH: Fatigue? Weight gain/loss? Hair/skin/nail problems? Let's check your thyroid.

*PSA: Men over 50 (and sometimes earlier) should have a screening for prostate cancer.

*Vitamin D: This is important for bone health! Usually expensive and not covered well by insurances, so having it drawn here at a reduced price is a super smart thing to do!


