City of Hanover Annual City Wide Clean Up Update

The City of Hanover Mayor and Council Members met June 14, 2023 at 6pm for their regular council meeting. On the agenda, was the discussion of the 2023 City Wide Clean Up. Invoices from Jones Trash Services and Washington Public Works were delivered to the city and were more than double the budgeted amount as the trash had to be manually sorted as unacceptable items were placed in the dumpsters.

Since the rules put in place by the city were not followed, the council made the decision that they will no longer provide dumpsters for a city-wide cleanup day. The county does provide Free Dump Days each year and these dates will be shared with the community.

★ **NO** CHILD 8 YEARS AND YOUNGER CAN BE AT THE POOL UNLESS WITH A PARENT/GUARDIAN OR A BABYSITTER 12 YEARS OR OLDER!!

--PARENT/GUARDIAN OR BABYSITTER MUST BE IN THE **POOL AREA** WITH THE CHILD(REN) WHILE THEY ARE SWIMMING AT ALL TIMES

--IF A MANAGER OR GUARD NOTICES A CHILD THAT DOES NOT HAVE A PARENT OR BABYSITTER WITH THEM AT THE POOL THE CHILD WILL HAVE TO SIT OUT UNTIL THE PARENT/GUARDIAN OR BABYSITTER IS BACK AT THE POOL

★ CHILDREN THAT ARE 8 MAY TAKE A SWIMMING TEST TO SEE IF THEY ARE ALLOWED TO BE AT THE POOL WITHOUT A PARENT/GUARDIAN PRESENT

Benefits to Boredom

June is such a busy month! As a parent I always feel like May is busy and trick myself into thinking that things will slow down once school is out—and then June hits! Dance recitals, baseball games, vacations, swimming lessons, sports camps, summer leagues--it's so easy to over-schedule your time!

Recent studies have shown that there are benefits to letting our kids be “bored.” In this digital age it is so easy for parents to put their kids in front of a screen when they hear the words, “I’m bored.” As we all know, this can be very convenient, but it isn’t always the best option. The following is a list of reasons that boredom can be a positive thing:

- *Boredom has been shown to increase creativity. When kids are left to find a way to cure their own boredom instead of having someone do it for them they naturally become more creative.
- *Boredom can improve mental health. Allowing our brains to relax and take a break from constant stimulation and distractions can help alleviate stress.
- *Boredom can lead to new adventures! When a person develops boredom and becomes unsatisfied with the status quo, they begin to seek out new things to try.
- *Boredom help develop resilience. Kids learn to deal with uncomfortable emotions and feelings when faced with boredom.

Parents shouldn’t feel like it is their responsibility to entertain their kids every minute of every day. There are advantages to letting your kid try to figure it out on their own. Trying to find a way to keep your kids included and involved with their peers while not over-committing their time can be a challenge, but the benefits of backing off and allowing them to experience a little bit of boredom can lead to many benefits!
