RECYCLING TRAILER


- ⇒ NO metal is to be brought down to this trailer!! There is not a pickup service for this!

- ⇒ PLEASE make sure all your items make it into the trailer!! If there is not a designated spot for items DO NOT put them in the trailer!! DO NOT leave your trash at the trailer!! There is no pick up service for this!!

DUMP SITE

- ⇒ CITY RESIDENTS USE ONLY!

HPM Partners with Hanover Hospital to Provide Local Treatments By Jayda Edgar, DNP, APRN, FNP-C

We are excited to be collaborating with various specialties and providers regarding bringing new services to our community. Most recently these services include aesthetics (Botox, Xeomin, Dermal Fillers), pain management, dermatology and the Nexplanon implant (birth control implant). One of these services, Holistic Pain Management (HPM), has been coming since late spring and offers a wide variety of specialized options for chronic pain management.

HPM Partners with Hanover Hospital to Provide Local Treatments

A new partnership between Hanover Hospital and HPM is bringing pain management services to rural residents suffering from chronic pain. HPM is a healthcare organization that specializes in advanced pain care treatments, such as nerve blocks, radiofrequency ablations, and injections. These procedures can help patients with various painful conditions, such as back and neck pain, spine injuries, knees and shoulder pain, headaches, sports and work-related injuries, inflammation, and arthritis.

HPM works with local hospital staff and collaborates with individual patients' primary care providers to diagnose and treat patients with chronic pain in Hanover, Kansas, and nearby areas. This partnership is part of HPM's mission to provide high-quality pain care to rural residents in places where specialized healthcare resources are often scarce or unavailable.

"Our goal is to reduce pain and improve function in patients suffering from chronic pain, particularly those living in rural areas," said Ryan Shedd, CEO of HPM. "We are on a mission to make it easier and faster for folks to find relief." With HPM now operating in Hanover, patients can expect to be able to schedule an appointment within three weeks or less. "We take a highly personalized approach to identifying the true source of a patient's pain. Our team of medical practitioners are trained to ask questions, listen carefully, and provide as much relief as possible," said Shedd. "Every patient's treatment is customized."
