Medicare vs. Medicare Advantage



HERE ARE SOME THINGS WE THINK YOU SHOULD KNOW!

Open enrollment for Medicare is October 15-December 7. So what should you choose? Medicare? Medicare Advantage? Ultimately the choice is yours. However, here are some facts that may be of interest to you. Original Medicare has two parts. Part A which consists of your hospital coverage for in patient and skilled nursing care, and Part B which covers physician services. Medicare Advantage is a health plan called Part C which is offered by private insurance companies as an alternative to Original Medicare. It replaces and cancels your Original Medicare plan if you choose this option. It provides the benefits of Part A, B, and often D, usually for about the same amount. They can carry hidden risks, especially for people with major health issues. You could end up paying unexpectedly high costs when you become ill or you find that your network lacks the providers you need. Most rural Providers/Hospitals shy away from accepting Medicare Advantage plans due to the delay in medical treatment from restrictions placed by the insurance provider. Most Advantage plans will require a pre authorization before authorizing medical treatment. A 2021 study found that rural Medicare Advantage plan enrollees were nearly twice as likely to switch back to their Original Medicare as opposed to those in Urban areas. 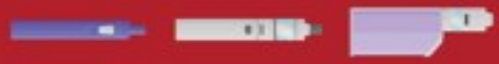

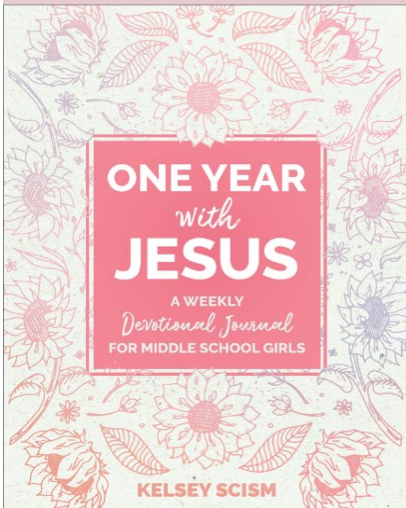
